GSB Session Schedule Change Proposals Background:

Initial working group survey discussions in Oct/Nov highlighted the desire to shorten session while maintaining program rigor. To achieve this, we created a draft schedule that eliminates Saturday morning classes and moves graduation up to Thursday evening.

- 1. Eliminating Saturday morning classes and moving graduation to Thursday evening has the following implications:
 - a. Checkout moved to Friday morning to accommodate travel
 - b. Shift 'Look Ahead' session to in-person and allow for interactive Q&A with Alumni Panel or another format TBD
 - c. FiSim schedule revision to allow for additional turns
 - d. Group 1 elective sessions reduced
 - e. Group 5 electives eliminated from in-person schedule
 - f. Year 1 students do not have an elective
- 2. Shift Financial Management courses to Year 2 and replace with Law and Regulation to Year 1.

Discussion and Recommendation:

- 1. Eliminating Saturday morning classes and moving graduation to Thursday evening has the following implications:
- I. Revise the FiSim schedules to allow time for required turns. Group recommendation is to add a virtual turn and provide a window of time for group work. Group sees little disruption to anything else in the schedule and nothing lost in the student experience virtually.
 - a. Schedule example -- Sunday virtual –open up Saturday morning and due by X:XX PM Sunday
 - b. Group sees practicality and value to virtual decision making
- II. Group 1 electives to be reduced from three to two sessions
- III. Group 5 electives removed from in-person schedule
 - a. Proposal presented to offer these in a virtual environment in June-July. One Group 5 elective would be required, but students would have access to all.
 - b. Group sees this as a big value-add for students
- IV. Electives removed from Year 1

- a. The group does not see this as a concern. Alternatively, there may be value in having a uniform Year 1 experience for students and setting the foundation for following years
- 2. Shift Financial Management courses to Year 2 and replace with Law and Regulation to Year 1.
 - I. Shifting the courses creates a more balanced schedule and allows for Financial Management to be spread across the student journey rather than frontloaded in Year 1
 - a. Group in favor of this change. Dave Koch actively working with faculty to make schedule changes.

GSB Session Student Survey Response Rates Background:

Survey response rates remain low for GSB session courses limiting actional feedback for future improvements.

Discussion and Recommendation:

Continually improving the student experience is a priority for staff and faculty. Student surveys are a primary way for us to gauge their perspective on the GSB experience and low response rates give us little actionable data to make future improvements.

- 1. Pilot a requirement that surveys are to be completed before a.) projects/quizzes are assigned or b.) grades are released
 - a. Group agrees with this pilot approach for 2025. Uniform messaging to students is that their voice is important for us to make meaningful improvements.
 - b. Group is not in favor of being required to provide time during class; this is left to faculty discretion if they prefer to do so.
- 2. Recommend a review of survey questions to ensure they're meaningful for both students and faculty/GSB staff.
